- Establish Chelmsford's second Park and Ride, probably at the A130/A131 junction, including a bus link to Broomfield Hospital.
- Downgrade the A130 between the Walthams and Dunmow.

### Campaigning against rat-running



Main Road, Broomfield is difficult enough already. Rat-running and hospital related traffic going through Broomfield is close to 70% of the problem. It certainly can't deal with the traffic from 800 more houses.

Liberal Democrat Malcolm Taylor says: "We need Park and Ride located to the north, and other measures to discourage traffic that has no business here!"

### Campaigning for our NHS

TEN YEARS after Labour came to power, Britain is facing the worst round of NHS cuts seen since the last Conservative Government.

Services are under threat across Britain including many hospitals, A&E and maternity services.

Malcolm Taylor says: "The Lib Dems want a halt to the current round of NHS cuts. We are campaigning to cut waste, so more money can be spent on frontline services."



### Potholes and Pavements



Our local roads and pavements are in a dreadful state because Conservative-controlled Essex County Council has failed to invest in maintaining them.

The Liberal Democrats have put pressure on the council to spend more on our pavements, and now they have agreed to invest more in getting vital repairs done.

Liberal Democrat Malcolm Taylor says "After years of lobbying from the Lib Dems, Essex County Council has finally realised the need to take action."

### Pushing for higher recycling

Liberal Democrats are calling for a separate weekly collection of kitchen waste, and other changes to raise Chelmsford's recycling performance.

More recycling means less waste going to landfill, which means less landfill tax, which means less pressure on your Council Tax.

Malcolm Taylor says "Lib Dem plans to increase recycling are good for the environment, and good for your pocket."

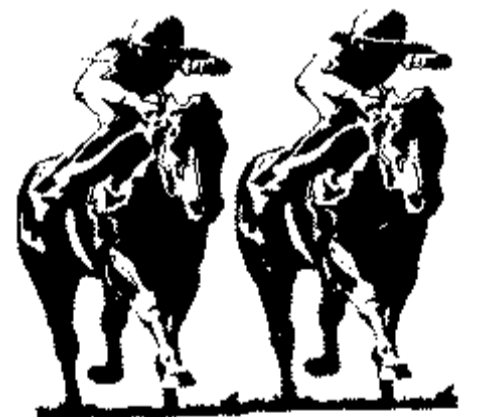
