Stansted Airport Application Refused



Liberal Democrat Councillors voted against BAA's application for more flights at Stansted Airport. Lib Dem Councillor Catherine Dean comments "More flights will speed up climate change and spoil the local environment. It is a shame that local Conservatives are so divided on this vital issue for our area."

Liberal Democrat-controlled Uttlesford District Council has refused Stansted Airport's application to expand beyond 25 million passengers per year, and increase the number of flights per year allowed from the existing runway.

"This is the right decision for the local community, and the right decision for the global environment," said local Liberal Democrat Councillor David Morson.

Unacceptable Impact

"The impact of the proposed increase in flights and passengers would have an unacceptable impact on noise levels, air quality and the overall quality of life. The Airport has also failed to produce adequate proposals to improve the rail service and show how they would deal with increased road traffic."

BAA has already appealed against the refusal, but the Council will mount a robust defence of the decision it has taken.

Cllr Catherine Dean added: "All the work that has been done over the last six months, and the evidence that has been gathered, will put us in a strong position at a public inquiry."

Conservative Flip-Flop

In contrast, Lord Hanningfield, the Conservative Leader of Essex County Council, says that Uttlesford District Council has made a mistake in voting against expansion.

Lib Dems Fight Expansion

Liberal Democrat Councillor David Morson commented "I am deeply disappointed that Essex Conservatives have not been totally on board with this. Liberal Democrats are sticking to their guns and are going to fight Stansted expansion all the way."

Lib Dem MPs Back Airport Refusal

Lib Dem Shadow Transport and Environment Secretaries, Alistair Carmichael MP and Chris Huhne MP have both backed Uttlesford District Council for making the right decision on airport expansion.

Alistair Carmichael said: "The Government's White Paper on aviation was fundamentally flawed. In the light of the Stern review it is clear that the Government's plans for expansion of aviation need to be completely revised."

"Until this takes place it would be absolute folly to make any plans to allow rapid expansion of airports in the overheated south east of Britain."

"The Stern review should be a wake up call to the Government. A new approach is needed to planning airport expansion, as the Uttlesford Liberal Democrats rightly recognise."

Local Lib Dems are committed to tackling the need for more affordable local housing. There are many people on the Council's waiting list looking for housing. Whilst there is a need to build some new housing to meet local needs, there is also a great need to use the housing that is already available.

In order to tackle the problem, Liberal Democrat-controlled Uttlesford Council has launched a scheme to enable empty homes to be leased to a housing association, who in turn could access regional housing money to renovate the property and rent it out.

Liberal Democrat Councillor David Morson says: "Too many houses are standing empty. They blight communities, attract crime and devalue neighbouring properties. I am delighted that Uttlesford is taking action to make empty homes available to those who need housing."

Liberal Democrats are working hard to promote energy conservation in order to cut CO2 emissions. There are many simple things that you can do, which will save you money, and help to reduce global warming.

- Replace your old boiler. It could reduce your water heating bills by 20-40% or between £190-£240 per year. It could also reduce your carbon emissions by as much as a tonne.
 - Insulate your hot water tank with a jacket at least 75mm (3 inches) thick. Doing so could save you between £10-£20 a year, and reduce your carbon emissions by 150 kg a year.
 - Fill your cavity walls with insulation. It could save you between £70-£120 per year, and reduce your carbon emissions by up to a tonne.
- A British Gas-funded scheme offers Council Tax rebates worth up to £75 each to local residents who install energy-efficient measures in their homes. The Council has been declared a highly commended runner-up in the prestigious National Energy Efficiency Awards and has offered local residents a DVD on home energy conservation.
