Stansted Airport Application Refused



Lib Dem MPs Back Airport Refusal

Lib Dem Shadow Transport and Environment Secretaries, Alistair Carmichael MP and Chris Huhne MP have both backed Uttlesford District Council for making the right decision on airport expansion.

Alistair Carmichael said: "The Government's White Paper on aviation was fundamentally flawed. In the light of the Stern review it is clear that the Government's plans for expansion of aviation need to be completely revised."

"Until this takes place it would be absolute folly to make any plans to allow rapid expansion of airports in the overheated south east of Britain."

"The Stern review should be a wake up call to the Government. A new approach is needed to planning airport expansion, as the Uttlesford Liberal Democrats rightly recognise."

Liberal Democrat-controlled Uttlesford District Council has refused Stansted Airport's application to expand beyond 25 million passengers per year, and increase the number of flights per year allowed from the existing runway.

"This is the right decision for the local community, and the right decision for the global environment," said local Liberal Democrat Councillor Alan Dean.

Unacceptable Impact

"The impact of the proposed increase in flights and passengers would have an unacceptable impact on noise levels, air quality and the overall quality of life. The Airport has also failed to produce adequate proposals to improve the rail service and show how they would deal with increased road traffic."

BAA has already appealed against the refusal, but the Council will mount a robust defence of the decision it has taken.

Cllr Anne Marchant added: "All the work that has been done over the last six months, and the evidence that has been gathered, will put us in a strong position at a public inquiry."

Conservative Flip-Flop

In contrast, Lord Hanningfield, the Conservative Leader of Essex County Council, says that Uttlesford District Council has made a mistake in voting against expansion.

Lib Dems Fight Expansion

Liberal Democrat Councillor Geoffrey Sell commented "I am deeply disappointed that Essex Conservatives have not been totally on board with this. Liberal Democrats are sticking to their guns and are going to fight Stansted expansion all the way."

Save Our 333 Bus Service

Local residents have continued to contact Councillor Alan Dean to complain about Excel bus company's plan to abandon the 333 bus service from Stansted Mountfitchet to Epping via Bishops Stortford and Harlow. The service is a lifeline to local residents who don't have cars because it serves local hospitals and town centres.

"Once again local people are being dumped in favour of the airport. Excel prefers to compete against other bus companies for passengers from the airport than serve residents to get to the hospital and shops."

A meeting of the Uttlesford Transport Forum heard that poor standards of service by Excel and cut throat competition for airport business had led to this vital link for local residents of Stansted being abandoned.

"I have still not received any positive response from Essex County Council," said



Alan Dean, at the end of January. "The County Council are doing a poor job at supporting bus services in this area. They can't even get timetables installed properly on bus stops."
