



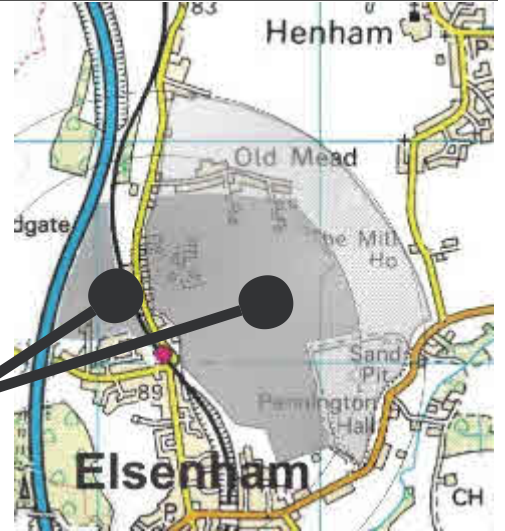

Tories threaten to build a new town in Elsenham

The Tories have:

- Pushed through a District Council proposal for 3,000 homes in Elsenham without any evidence.
- Ignored the 59% of those replying to the District Council's consultation who opposed a single new settlement in Uttlesford.
- Ignored the 87% of Elsenham residents who did not wish further expansion of the village.
- Refused to hold a Special Area Panel Meeting to tell residents about the decision.

The Lib Dems are fighting to protect your interests

- Called in the Tories' decision for review by the Council's scrutiny committee on 3rd October.
 - Argued that no specific location should be named for the houses at this stage, until further research by the Council's officers is available.
 - Demanded that a public meeting be held for residents (2nd October in Elsenham Village Hall).

Why you should oppose the Conservative proposals

- The road infrastructure is inadequate: Grove Hill in Stansted, Elsenham level crossing and a rat run through Bedwell Rd and Pound Lane in Ugley Green
- There is uncertainty about whether more roads would be provided.
- Commuter trains are already overcrowded.
- Elsenham and Henham would be effectively combined.
- The proposals are linked to airport expansion.

To: Cllr. Jim Ketteridge, Leader of Uttlesford District Council and Leader of Uttlesford District Council's ruling Conservative councillors.

I/We call upon the Conservative councillors who are responsible for running Uttlesford District Council to reconsider their preferred option of a 3,000-home new town between Elsenham and Henham, or any large-scale developments options until there are proper studies on the impact on these communities.

The Elsenham new town would be bigger than Stansted Mountfitchet is today and would rely on roads planned for a second runway at Stansted Airport. Large housing numbers added to any community in Uttlesford would be too much of a burden on our existing infrastructure.

The Council should think again and plan properly where Uttlesford's new housing should be located.
