STANDING UP FOR STANSTED: OUR MANIFESTO

On **Thursday May 3rd**, voters in Stansted will have the choice between a Lib Dem team with a **record of action** in our village, and the Conservatives who, on Uttlesford District Council, are selling Stansted short.

The **Liberal Democrats** are the **best choice** to continue leading on Stansted Parish Council. If you vote Lib Dem on May 3rd, this is what we will do for our village:

#1 No More Large-Scale Development

That's the Lib Dems' top priority for the Parish Council. We will continue to oppose any large-scale development in Stansted while Forest Hall Park is still being built.



We are committed to ensuring that Stansted remains a village and is not choked by excessive development. By contrast the Conservative-led district council has suggested more sites for development in our village than any other settlement in the district.

#2 Keep Stansted Police in Stansted

As part of their programme of cut-backs, Essex Police have already closed the front desk at Stansted police station, and are now looking to close the station altogether. There is a danger that our local police officers could end up being based as far away as Dunmow.



We will work with the police to ensure that Stansted officers are working in Stansted as much as possible.

#3 The Best Local Services: in Stansted, For Stansted

The Lib Dems have already delivered excellent services for Stansted - like play equipment and a skate park for our children. We led the fight to save our post office and oppose airport expansion.



We want to continue delivering the best services possible for our village by keeping up the pressure for a much-needed new health centre, a 'one stop shop' for public services including an expanded library and citizens' advice facilities, and newer, better amenities that are accessible to all.

#4 Safer, Better Roads

The Lib Dems are calling for an end to the parking madness on Cambridge Road, and Lib Dem-led Stansted Parish Council has already put measures in place to reduce congestion on Grove Hill.



We are working together with local residents to make our roads safer - fighting for a new crossing on Church Road and Silver Street, putting pressure on authorities to fill pot-holes and helping to set up a community speed watch to stop drivers speeding through our village.
